MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

Actors Co-op meets weekly on Monday evenings from approx. 7:00 pm – 9:45 pm. Regular attendance is expected. Because we are a co-operative company, we are responsible for all aspects of production, including membership dues of \$25.00 per month.

Each member is required to put in work hours on every main stage production and participate on a production team. Production teams are:

Tech Team: Meets one time per production (usually Saturday mornings) to hang lights for shows.

PR Team: Jobs range from pick-ups of printed materials, to press releases, to social media posts to e-blast or web design. Job requirements vary per job.

Donor Team: (Most of this work is done at home) Members are assigned a portion of donors to Actors Co-op and are required to keep regular email correspondence. Time commitment varies.

Concessions/House Managing: Every member works 4-6 concessions or house managing shifts throughout the year.
